- Coastal destination resorts & sports betting (taxed, regulated, local option)
- Direct manufacturer-to-consumer auto sales (Tesla & others)

- Home-built homes, barndominiums, container homes — no forced contractors or bans
- Hundreds of unnecessary occupational licenses gone
- Permanent revenue stream to finish eliminating property taxes

Revenue from new freedoms completes the total phase-out of property taxes (**Cultivate Act** started it — **Freedom Act** finishes it).
